aboard Captain Bota



There is nothing as enticing as the clear blue sky touching the crystal waters of the Adriatic when aboard a small passenger ship.

The brand new Captain Bota is a gem in the fleet of yacht-like ships built in the Split shipyard according to the latest EU standards applicable to small ship cruising.

With the friendly crew of 7 members Captain Bota offers an intimate atmosphere accommodating up to 38 passengers in her 18 spacious cabins with private facilities and air conditioning.

Nicely appointed public areas located on the upper deck include a spacious restaurant with panoramic windows adjacent to a largeterrace with deck chairs and tables where you can spend your time at leisure and enjoy your open air breakfast. For swim lovers there is a large platform with two ladders as well as public showers.

Sundeck with loungers on the top most level measures 250 square meters and features a wow factor – an open air Jacuzzi.

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Launching in 2015 Captain Bota is just perfectly designed for your relaxed and rejuvenating retreat while sampling the very best of the fabled Dalmatian coast with its little islands, romantic bays and medieval ports.

Cabin information

The M/S Captain Bota accommodates up to 38 passengers in her 18 spacious cabins situated on two decks, namely main and lower deck.

All passengers` cabins are air conditioned and conveniently designed with private en suites. Flexible bed configuration includes either TWIN (2 single beds) or DOUBLE (European Queen-size) arrangements with beds measuring 200x90 cm or 200x160 cm.

On request an additional third bed may be added in few cabins.

There is an independent air-conditioning control board in each cabin, designed wallboards, working desk with chair, couch, mirror, night lamps, safe, radio, SAT TV, hair dryer, 220 V electric supply, large wardrobe and luggage space under beds. The cabins are equipped with life jackets, safety and fire alarm as well as PA sound system.

Main Deck

There are 10 cabins measuring 13-15 sq. m. with double or twin beds, including one cabin with third bed (not bunk bed). Each cabin have a large window and porthole in the bathroom.

Lower Deck

There are 8 cabins measuring 14-16 sq. m. with with double or twin beds, including one cabin with third bed (not bunk bed). Lower deck cabins have entry doors from inside of the corridor. There are two portholes in each cabin as well as an additional dual ventilation system.

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Amenities

Sailing under Croatian flag the 38 -passenger M/S Captain Bota has designed for a comfortable sailing along the Croatian coast.

She is powered by two engines for an average cruising speed of 9 knots, few generators for 220 V electrical supply including full air conditioning, bow thruster and the latest electronic equipment.

The M/S Captain Bota is a steel made vessel where mahogany and iroko woods have been also applied for decking and flooring as well as insulation materials used according to the latest EU standards.

Upper deck features a fully air conditioned salon -restaurant with panoramic windows measuring over 100 square meters with an additional buffet breakfast corner, bar and an adjacent 70 square meter terrace for a breathtaking view. The terrace is equipped with deck chairs and tables and may be covered in case of unpleasant winds.

Kitchen (galley) is made in accordance with the newest HACCP standards where

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Mediterranean and international meals are prepared for the guests on board.

For swim lovers Captain Bota offers a swimming platform with 2 ladders with handrails for an easy access to the water as well as two outdoor showers and toilettes. Unlike bathroom towels the beach towels may be additionally rented on board.

On the top most ship's level there is a fenced sundeck which covers an area of 250 square meters with loungers at disposal to all the passengers on board as well as a rooftop Jacuzzi. For guests' additional comfort the sundeck is partly covered with sunshades.

ITINERARY:

The cruise features a nice combination of lovely swim stops and learning lessons with a round trip itinerary from Split that calls on little ports of four Dalmatian islands, Dubrovnik and Makarska Riviera.

Each stop along the way is a discovery itself; jewels and hideaways that make this route a delight in exploration, culture and romance. We look forward to welcoming you on board M/S Captain Bota!

DAY 1 · SATURDAY SPLIT

Our cruise conveniently embarks in Split, the largest Dalmatian city. The M/S Captain Bota will be docked in the main Split harbor and the cabins will be at your disposal starting from 13:00 (1:00 p.m.). Please feel free to leave your luggage on board in case of your earlier arrival. Meet your fellow passengers, the Captain and our friendly crew over welcome reception followed by dinner at 19:30 (7:30 p.m.). Dinner meal will be also served to the guests arriving with late evening flights. Overnight stay in Split.

DAY 2 • SUNDAY SPLIT - BOL - HVAR

We start our day with the morning departure towards Bol situated on Brac Island. Bol is well known for its pebbled beach called Zlatni Rat, claimed to be the most beautiful beach on the Croatian coast. Immerse yourself in a bath of sun and sea water or explore the town of Bol before lunch and continuation of our journey to Hvar where we will arrive in the late afternoon/early evening hours. Experience the enchanting town of Hvar situated on the island of the same name. Hvar is claimed to be the most popular Croatian island which you

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may realize while feeling the vibe of its bustling promenade, well-appointed cafes, wine stores, shops and restaurants. Join an evening walking tour to learn on the history and heritage of Hvar followed by presentation of centuries long lavender farming tradition. Overnight stay in Hvar.

DAY 3 • MONDAY HVAR – KORCULA

Enjoy another tranquil and relaxing day as we smoothly glide towards Korcula Island having a swim break en route. In the late afternoon hours we arrive in the town of Korcula. You will find yourself in front of the town walls and the historic town gate, a reminder of glory and power of this little medieval place. It is just down the street that the famous traveller Marco Polo was born in 1254 coming from a noble family of Korcula town. You can savor all the uniqueness of Korcula by strolling its cobbled, narrow and shady lanes where you will find handcraft stores and shops with jewellery made from local coral germs. Learn about Korcula during our walking tour, enjoy rest of the evening in a laid back atmosphere of this jewel town and find a restaurant at your choice. Overnight stay in Korcula.

DAY 4 • TUESDAY KORCULA – DUBROVNIK

Today we sail along the shores of Mljet and Elaphiti islands where we will have a swim stop and lunch before an afternoon arrival in Dubrovnik. Meet our tour guide and board a coach to begin the city tour of Dubrovnik. Enjoy a panoramic drive offering a breathtaking scenery from a hill above Dubrovnik. We will then arrive in the Old Town Dubrovnik, the famous city enlisted as UNESCO's World Heritage site. After the city tour enjoy Dubrovnik on your own pace by exploring additional attractions such as City Walls or take a cable car ride to the hill of Srdj. The return coach transfer is scheduled in the evening hours. You may also choose to return to the ship on your own. Overnight stay in Dubrovnik.

DAY 5 • WEDNESDAY DUBROVNIK- ELAPHITI ISLANDS – MLJET ISLAND NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast we set sails for Mljet National park enjoying again the magnificent shores of the Elaphiti Islands, situated northwest from Dubrovnik. This will be another great opportunity to dip yourself in the crystal Adriatic or just relax on board. Lunch will be served during our sailing to Mljet. Explore the National park in the afternoon hours strolling around the Great and Small Lake and take a local boat ride to the Islet of St. Mary to visit the 12th century Benedictine Monastery. Overnight stay on Mljet Island.

DAY 6 • THURSDAY MLJET – MAKARSKA

Our sailing continues towards Makarska. We glide along the picturesque Peljesac Peninsula covered with olive groves, vineyards and pine forests. Upon refreshing swim stop enjoy lunch on board before an afternoon arrival in Makarska, a bustling regular jaunt for travellers. You will have a free evening to explore numerous restaurants, cafes and shops of the centre of Makarska Riviera. Overnight stay in Makarska.

DAY 7 • FRIDAY MAKARSKA - PUCISCA (BRAC ISLAND) - SPLIT

Upon crossing the Brac Channel we reach the largest coastal village on Brac Island called -Pucisca. Shiny and white stone facades rising amphitheatrically uphill make this place so unique and famous for its quarries from which stone was excavated to build limestone columns of the White House in Washington DC, The Parliament House in Vienna and many other famous buildings all over the world. Pucisca is also known for Stonemasonry School where students learn to carve local limestone with traditional and unconventional tools that have been used for centuries. In the afternoon hours we will return in Split. In 1700 year-old the historic core of Split inscribed under UNESCO World Heritage - and within a short walk distance from our ship- stands the massive Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, dating back to the 3rd A.D. In the course of time the Old Town of Split developed inside and around the Palace which included three Roman temples and a massive mausoleum. Join us for a walking tour and explore with our tour guide some of the numerous archaeological, historic and cultural sites of Split. Find your favourite restaurant for dinner, have a sip of wine or latte in one of many cafes on the pedestrian promenade called Riva and explore numerous shops in the city centre. Overnight stay in Split.

Optional excursion: National Park Krka. *Reservation and payment on board.
